

DUES SCHEDULE

WIRE REINFORCEMENT INSTITUTE

The following dues schedule is currently in effect. This schedule is subject to change at the discretion of the WRI Board of Directors and upon majority vote of the Board. Regular and Associate Members may choose to pay the annual billing quarterly, semi-annually, or annually. All dues are payable when invoice is rendered. All dues for members located outside the U.S. are payable in U.S. funds. Dues may be adjusted by 3% annually.

A five-level dues schedule based upon business consummated with the industry. A special category of non-direct sales volume with the industry has a fixed dues of \$1,595.00 per year.

**** For a Regular Member company having production facilities in both the U.S. and Canada or a Foreign Country, the annual dues will be based upon the application of the U.S. dues rate to tonnage produced in the U.S. and the Canadian/Foreign dues rate to tonnage produced in Canada or the Foreign Country. Tonnage sold to and shipped between WRI Regular Member companies shall be exempt from such dues calculations.***
